This philosophy rings true and is in the spirit of what we here at the ASPE South Florida Chapter work hard each day in promoting and supporting. At last month’s meeting we had the opportunity to learn about “Drinking Fountains and Bottle Fillers in a post Covid-19 world. A special thanks to Brian O’Keefe (National Strategic Account Manager at Oasis International) and to Adam Chiarugi (Regional Sales Manager at Oasis International) for sponsoring and presenting at the January 2021 ASPE South Florida Chapter meeting. Did you know bottle fillers reduce plastic bottle waste – an essential fact, since only about 25% of the plastic produced in the U.S. is recycled. They also save consumers money. With bottled water priced at \$1.50 per bottle, a 20-oz. bottle of water costs 7.5 cents per ounce. That doesn’t seem like a big deal until you compare it to gasoline. If you paid the same cost per ounce, gas would be \$9.60 per gallon.

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Legislative News

Enrique (Henry) Salvador—VP-Legislative



Greetings and welcome to the February Newsletter. This year has started to be a busy year for us. The topic I wanted to write about this month is on Virtual Inspections.

Did you know that the Department of Business and Professional Regulations Board of Building Code Administrators and Inspectors came out with a Declaratory Statement on virtual inspections back in 2018. This was done almost two years before the Covid 19 pandemic. The company Innovated Construction Inspections Inc. was the first company vetted by the BCAIB board. Manatee County has also followed up with the Board. This is a general statement and has been used by different areas around the State.

The Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals has Amended Chapter 1 and included this section.

110.3.13 VIRTUAL INSPECTIONS: When approved by the Building Official, virtual inspections as set forth in section 101.2.2 are limited to,

- Attachment of Mullion bars in window and the door installations for like in kind replacement.
- Roofing under 1500 square feet in compliance with section 1512.4.3.2 of this code.
- Tunnel replacement of building drains and water lines.
- Water heater replacement that does not require electric upgrade or new service.

Dade County leaves it up to each municipality and each Building Official to decide on how the due virtual inspections as per the emergency order. I would check in you area and see what is allowed.

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Education Update

Kyle Stottlemeyer—Education Chairman



To continue with my topic on COVID-19 and its impact on society today, please enjoy my article below:

The ongoing trend since 2020 is the importance of hygiene and hygienic products due to the COVID-19 outbreak. “Hygienic products — especially touch-free restroom products — are a theme that will only continue to gain momentum this year and moving forward as facilities retrofit from manual to sensor-based upgrades. By now, we are all well aware of the importance of hand hygiene and guarding against potential cross-contamination on ‘high-touch’ surfaces. Restroom guests feel most comfortable in an entirely touch-free environment, where flush valves, faucets, soap dispensers, hand dryers and more are all sensor-operated.”

Kris Alderson, senior marketing manager, Bradley Corp. agrees, saying upgrading restrooms with touchless fixtures is the hottest trend right now. “The ‘hands-free’ trend has been growing for years,” Alderson says. “Touchless benefits such as user convenience, minimizing germs, cleanliness and ease of maintenance have always resonated with the commercial plumbing market. But in 2020, the coronavirus pandemic accelerated demand for touchless technology, making it the new gold standard in restrooms.”

Bradley’s 2020 Healthy Handwashing Survey showed 91% of Americans think it’s important that commercial restrooms be equipped with touchless fixtures, and 90% say that their preference for touchless handwashing fixtures has risen since the pandemic. Further, making everything touchless is the top request for restroom improvements, Alderson notes.

“Today’s touchless handwashing models have never operated better due to new advanced sensing technology that ensures continuous and reliable washing,” he adds. “This new technology makes false activations and misfires an annoyance of the past. Beyond performance, hygiene and convenience, touchless fixtures are easier to keep clean, maintain and service than touch-activated fixtures.”

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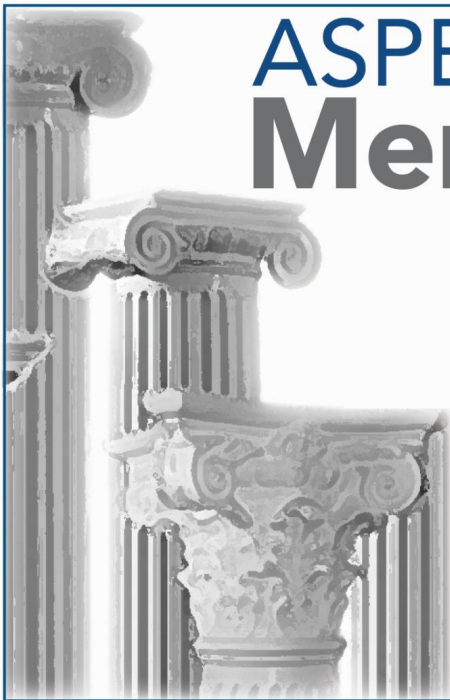
