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Legislative News

Enrique (Henry) Salvador—VP-Legislative



Greetings and welcome to the January newsletter. Hope everyone had time to give thanks and enjoy this holiday season. I would like to thank the South Florida ASPE Chapter for kicking off the season with a wonderful cocktail party on December 9th. For those of you who missed it we had a great time. The event was attended by the Board members, existing members and new members. We all had a wonderful time at the Tommy Bahama Restaurant in Dania Beach.

I would like to discuss some of the changes to the 2018 NFPA Chapter 99 2018 Health Care Facilities Code. The 2020 Florida Plumbing Code Chapter 15 references the NFPA 99 2018 Health Care Facilities Code. The 2018 code edition features numerous technical changes as well as provisions for new technology and materials. This code has added approximately 145 new sections, 21 section deletions, approximately text deletions & 112 figure/table revisions, and text deletions and 210 revisions. This totals 488 changes. Those figures do not include the rearrangement and revisions of Chapter 6 - Electrical or the completely new Chapter 15 - Dental Gas and Vacuum Piping Systems.

I'm going to touch on the most noteworthy changes:

Section 5.1.12.3.1.3 - Inspections shall be conducted by a party technically competent and experienced in the field of Medical Gas and Vacuum Pipeline Inspections, testing, and meeting the requirements of ASSE 6020 Professional for Medical Gas Systems Qualifications Standard for Medical Gas Systems Inspectors or ASSE 6030, Professional Qualifications Standards for Medical Gas System Verifiers. (This new section clearly states that anyone involved in the review or inspections of Medical Systems needs to have the required certification.)

Section 5.1.10.1.4 is a new section and addresses new and added technology. Listed corrugated tubing (CMT) fabricated from copper alloy that meets the standards is permitted for Medical Gas Installations. This is new addition to the standards has been tested and approved.

Chapter 15 - Dental Gas and Vacuum System was added to the code. The Chapter was created because these systems do not always readily fall under the requirements for Medical Gas and Vacuum as addressed in Chapter 5.

I have only highlighted some of the most significant changes to the 2018 NFPA 99 Code. The massive changes require in depth review for designing, installing, and inspecting the Health Medical Gas Installations. When seminars and/or classes become available, we will notify you of the dates and locations.

Education Update

2022 is upon us, and COVID-19 has mutated into many different variants these days. Questions are being asked if our drinking water could be contaminated with the virus. The EPA has provided important information about COVID-19 as it relates to drinking water and wastewater to provide clarity to the public.

The COVID-19 virus has not been detected in drinking-water supplies. Based on current evidence, the risk to water supplies is low. Americans can continue to use and drink water from their tap as usual. Coronavirus, which causes COVID-19, is a type of virus that is particularly susceptible to disinfection and standard treatment and disinfectant processes are expected to be effective.

The EPA Administrator, Andrew Wheeler, sent a letter to Governors in all 50 states, territories, tribes and Washington, DC, requesting that water and wastewater workers, as well as the manufacturers and suppliers who provide vital services and materials to the water sector, are considered essential workers and businesses by state authorities when enacting restrictions to curb the spread of COVID-19. Our critical water infrastructure and its operators ensure the safe supply of water to our homes and hospitals, and depend on treatment chemicals, laboratory supplies and related goods and materials.

All this ties in with our Chapter Technical Meeting on Thursday, January 13th we hope to see you there.

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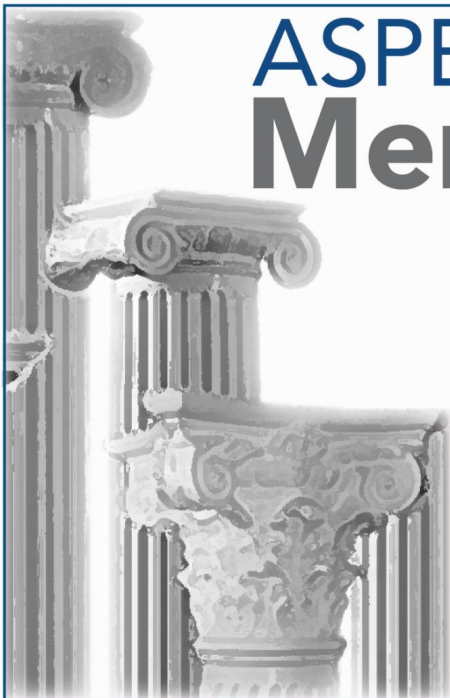
