As a continuation to what was presented on did you know that the latest update to the residential “Energy Gauge USA” software (version 7.0.00 database 7003) will now show the new required “UEF” (Uniform Energy Factor) of the water heater instead of the old “EF”? This update will make it easier to verify compliance without having to convert “EF” to “UEF” anymore.

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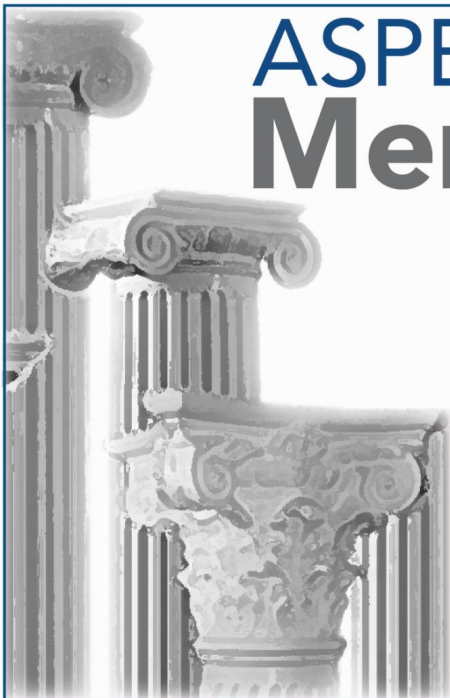

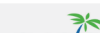
