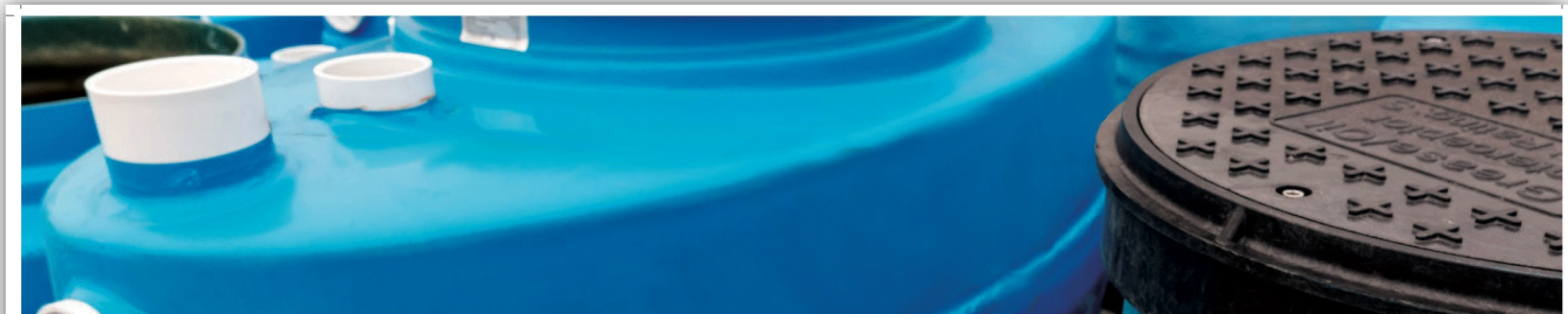

Elvira Pita-Mejia — WOA Liaison

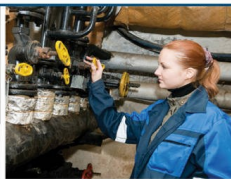
September is here and the Women of ASPE are ready to kick-off the 2021-22 ASPE year with a bang!

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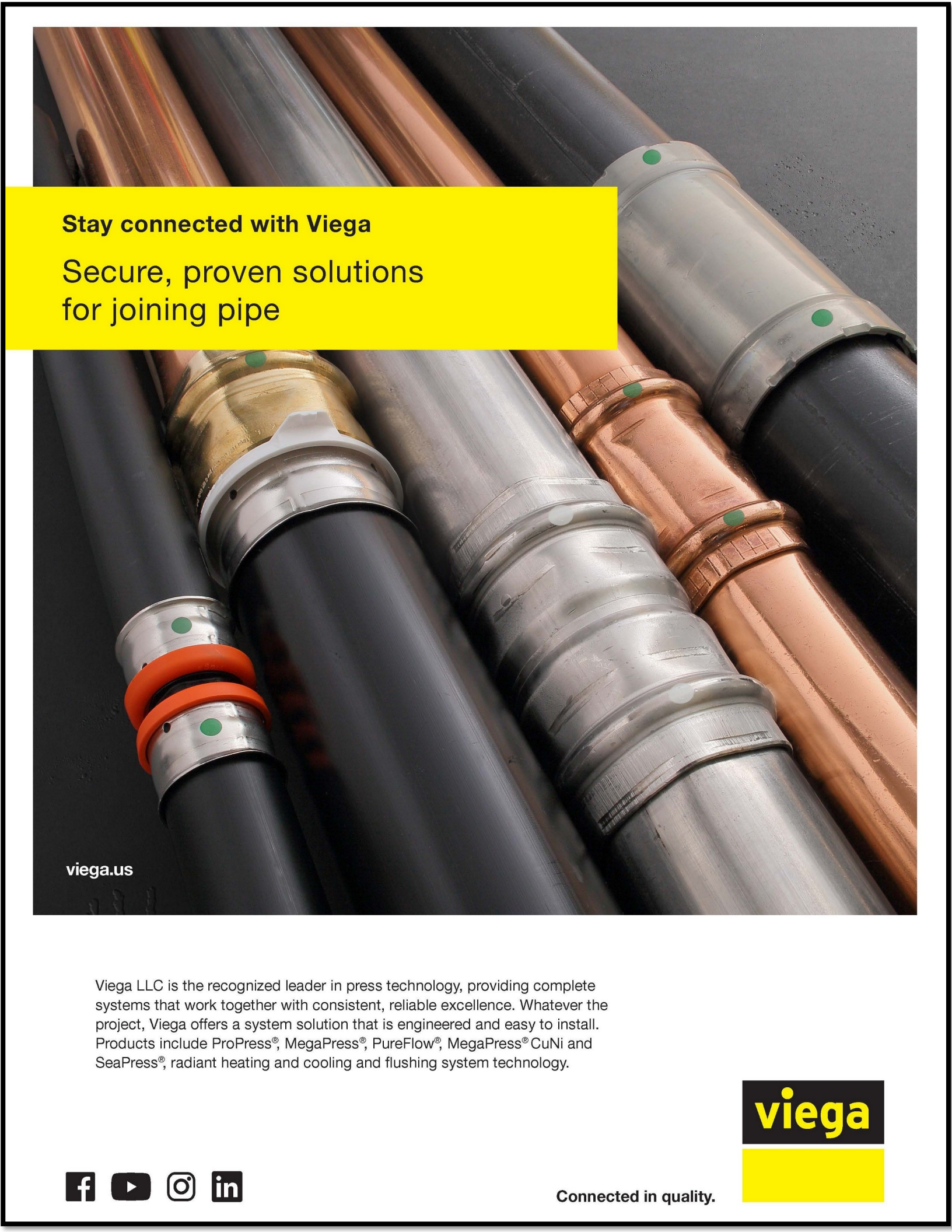

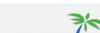
