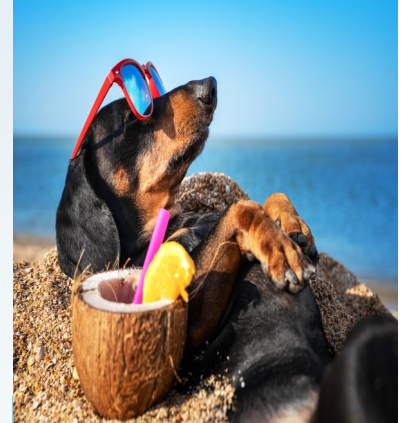

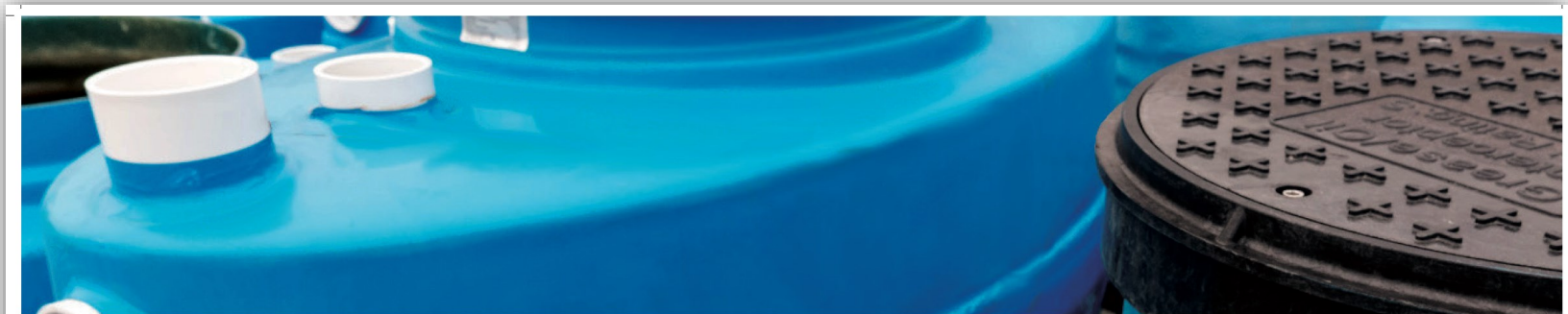

The Women of ASPE will also have a booth at the ASPE Tech Symposium. Please make sure to stop by.

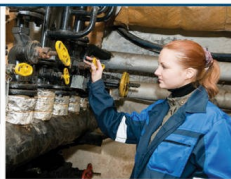

AYP Report

Matthew Cocking — AYP Liaison



Here we stand - dazed and shocked with heavy hearts, considering the recent building failure in south Florida. I find it difficult to come up with meaningful words at a time like this. I would like to express my deepest condolences to the loved ones of all who were affected, though condolences are hardly enough to match the sorrow felt by the communities touched by this tragedy. As young professionals who have chosen to be responsible for building and maintaining America's infrastructure, it is our duty to glean meaning from moments of tragedy such as the one we are currently faced with.

It oftentimes takes an event to occur to truly learn the finer points of a life lesson that may seem obvious in hindsight. I recall the first blunder of my professional career . . . I will spare myself the embarrassment and not share the details, but I was an early 20s, inexperienced engineer who buckled under external pressures and relinquished a document that was not ready to go out. I thought I was being helpful and proactive. It was not until after getting chewed out (admittedly, it was well deserved) that I realized the importance of constant vigilance. Even though this blunder involved a slumlord client and a single-family residence; even though this document was trivial and not signed and sealed by a P.E., I sent out a premature document with incorrect details. I had no real understanding of the potential impact of my decisions at this point in my career.

Even though this document was relatively inconsequential in the grand scheme of things, any document with incorrect details has the potential to tarnish the reputation of an engineering firm. It became clear to me that day that while I owe a loyalty to my employers to do the best job I can...I also owe loyalty to all my fellow employees and to their families and dependents to some degree. Every individual working at an engineering firm (or any building or contracting firm) is operating under the charge of a qualifying engineer; and making rash decisions like the one I did put that engineer's license at risk. Every person at a firm who is making mortgage payments or supporting a family or saving for retirement is depending on the good standing of the qualifiers license.

The engineering world is an environment where making decisions prematurely puts in jeopardy the financial security of the people around you. It made me physically sick to my stomach to know that I had potentially risked the livelihoods of so many people because I caved to the pressure of wanting to get a document out to please a client. I was fortunate enough to learn this career lesson in a manner that had minimal consequences.

It breaks my heart to learn a much more valuable career lesson through a tragedy that consumed lives. Not only do the decisions we make every day affect people around us that we know, but they may also affect many thousands of people that we will never know.

The decisions we make or do not make can impact entire communities, beyond what we are able to consider in any given moment.

With this, I would like to implore the young engineers of our industry to be thorough in all your professional dealings. Keep in mind that every decision you make, every calculation that comes across your desk . . . you may have to explain it to a judge. Be thorough in your work, no matter how tired or how confident you are. Dot every I and cross every T. Be absolutely certain of every detail on every piece of paper with your name or your company's name on it. If you find yourself under pressure in the field, have the courage to say 'No' to men and women who are intent to take advantage of your youth and inexperience. Embody a standard of excellence and demand excellence from the professionals around you.

For each decision we make goes towards building our habits. And each of our habits serves as a building block of our character. I currently have no insight as to the details of what caused such a catastrophic failure, but as an engineering professional, it struck a chord of terror in me that shook me to my very core. It reminds me of all the career lessons I have learned along the way, and it compels me to share the lessons I wish someone had taught me. I wish I knew the importance of always maintaining the utmost diligence without knowing the heartbreak and the terror that it takes to learn such lessons.

As we endeavor to discern teachable moments from recent tragedy, let us remember that every decision we make impacts countless lives. Let us apply this awareness in a manner that helps to improve our profession and our industry. Let us not forget that the systems we design, build, and maintain will (hopefully) outlive us - and all the present and future people who may benefit from our efforts. Knowing that catastrophic building failures are possible gives me pause and brings me to say:

Please, young professionals: I implore you. Be thorough and be vigilant. The work we do has impact far beyond our social periphery.

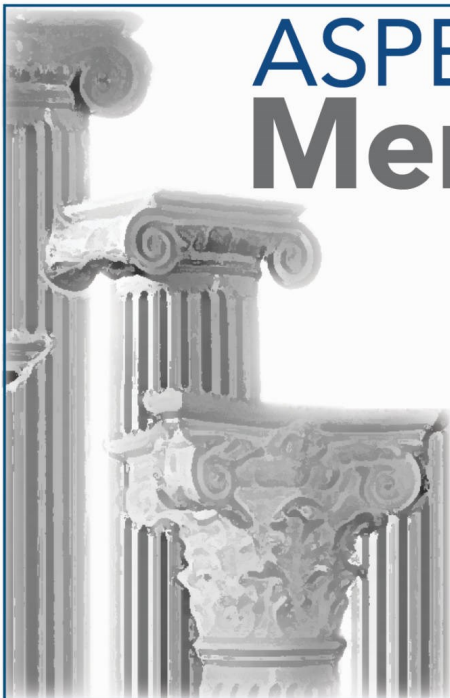

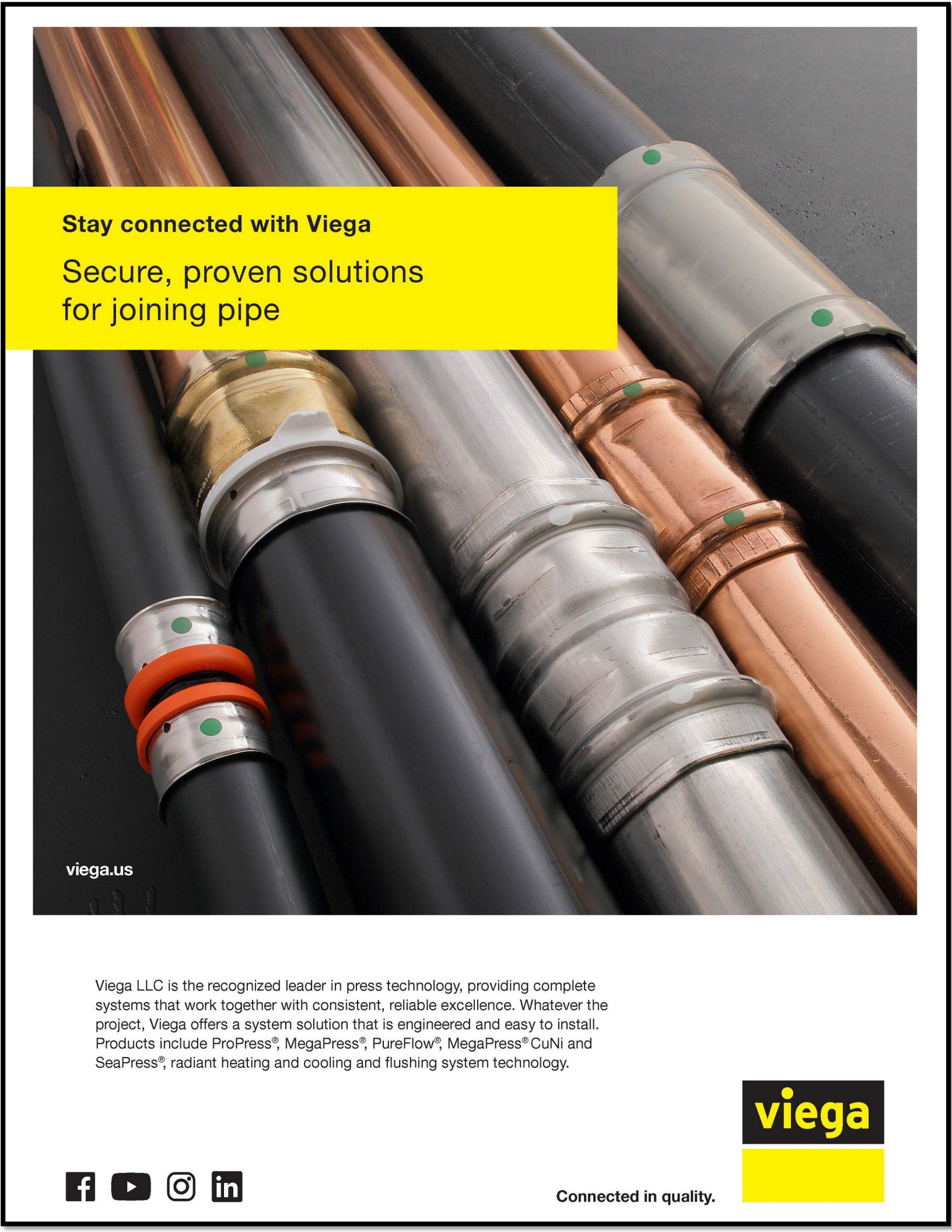
