Legislative news— Even if we feel that certain codes don't reflect the most efficient methods or what we have been doing for 20+ is the way we been doing it! We must have a current code section(s) to provide you if there is ever a comment being provided by a plan reviewer, a code section shall be provided to ensure there is no opinion/arbitrary comments being provided. I have provided the Florida Statue that requires the code official to perform their fiduciary duties.

In Florida, [Florida Statute 553.79](#) requires a plan reviewer to provide the specific code section(s) when rejecting a permit or requiring substantive changes to plans after a permit is issued. This ensures that building officials are transparent and provide a clear basis for their decisions, preventing arbitrary rejections or changes.

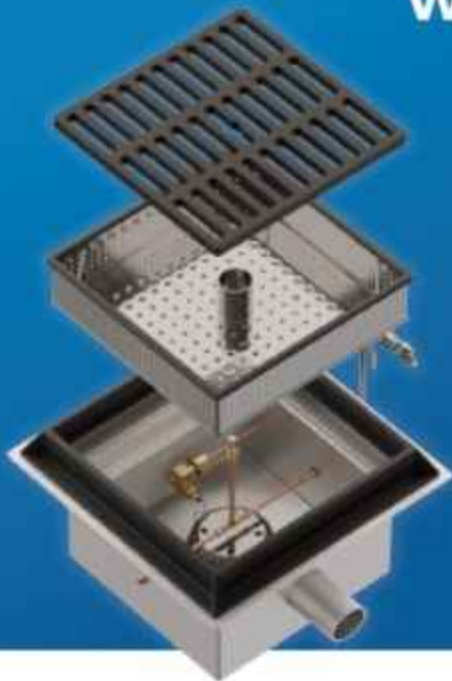


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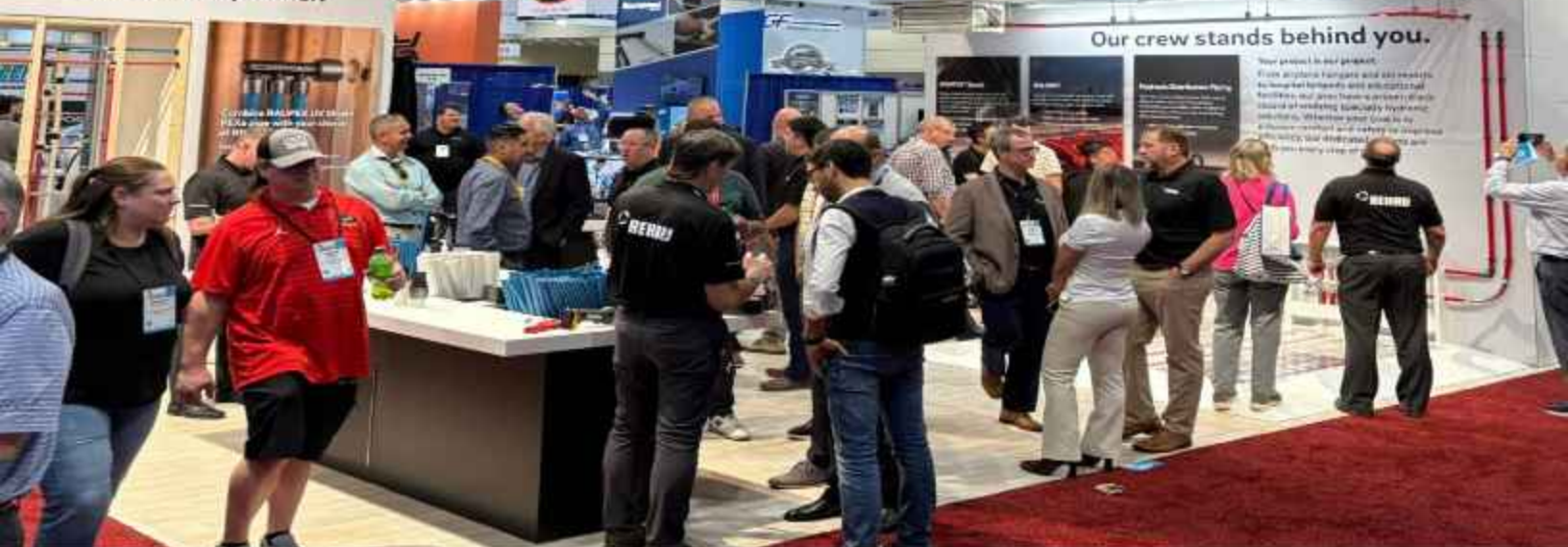
