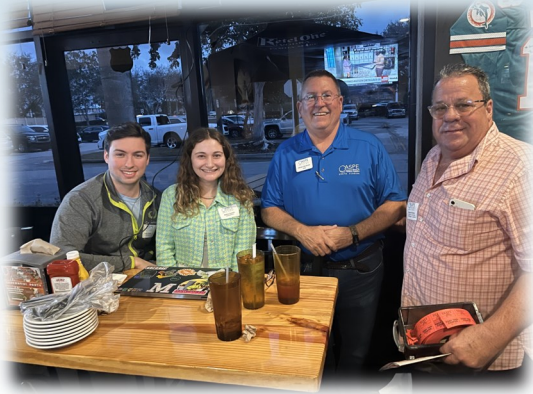

Enrique (Henry) Salvador—VP-Legislative



A lot of discussions and issues have been brought up with the new energy code and the installations of tank type water heaters in residential projects. The only heaters that met the (UEF) at the time are only up to 50 gallon residential tank type heaters. Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals has sent out an interpretation that the Light-Duty Commercial water heaters will rated in stand by laws and not UEF. Until this is changed, we will continue to allow 65 gallon, 80 gallon and 119 gallon water heaters. I would just install Heaters with heat pumps, since they are not as expensive as they used to be.

The New 2023 8th Edition Code will go into effect on December 31st 2023.

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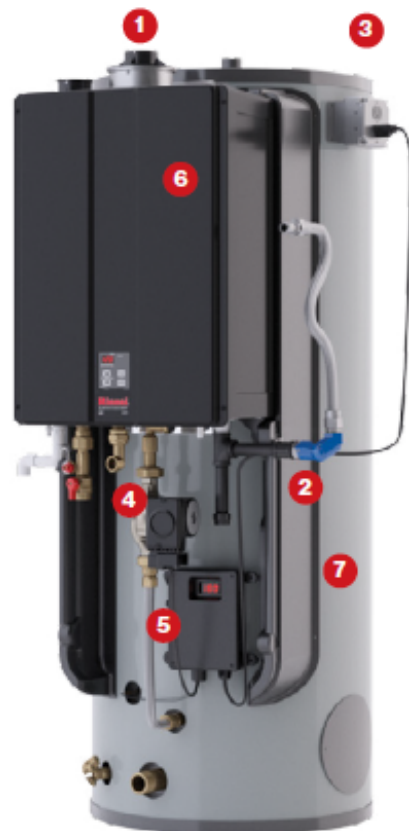

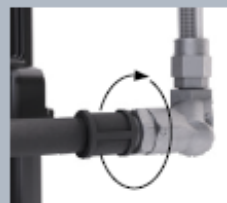
