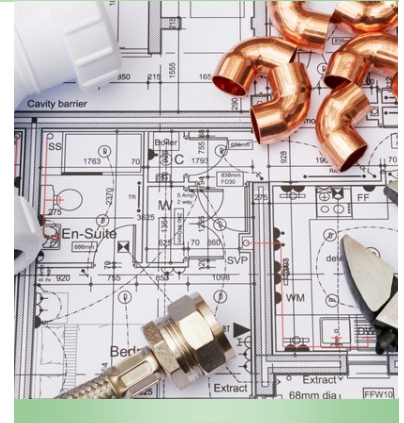

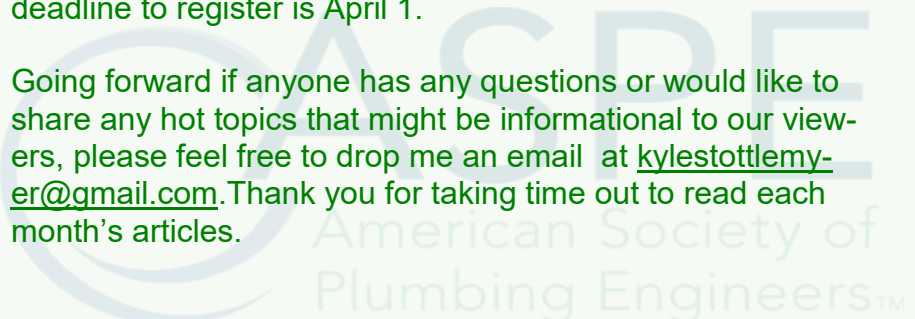

Legislative news—The Florida Building Code, Plumbing—Underground Cellular Core PVC in coastal areas has been learning curve for contractors/Engineers. If you were to review the installation manual (FBCP 303.2) for “cellular core PVC piping in unstable areas” and you will learn that solid wall PVC with hangers are required to be installed when in a coastal area. As the reviewer, we would make sure plans specify that and speak with the contractors to ensure they are aware. That “catch it in the field” mentality would be costly for everybody in the process.
