Grandfathering

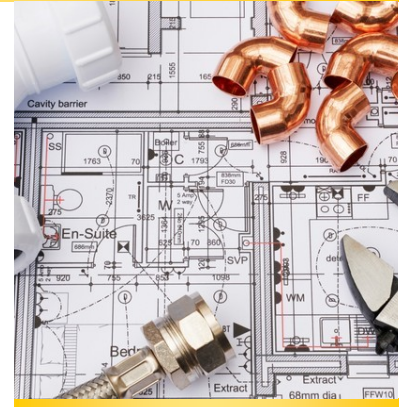


The term “grandfathering” is a very loosely and wrongly used concept that can get us in trouble as engineers.

Grandfathering is a provision in which an old rule continues to apply to some existing situations while a new rule will apply to all future cases, and it is commonly used as an excuse to not comply with the current building codes. For instance, you may have a client who asks the design team to leave an existing system as-is instead of making the required upgrades to meet the code as a way to save on budget, time, and space. They might claim, “We did that on another building, and it is ok.”

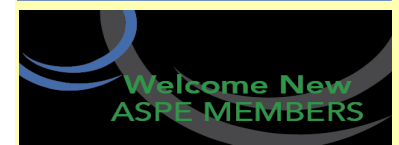

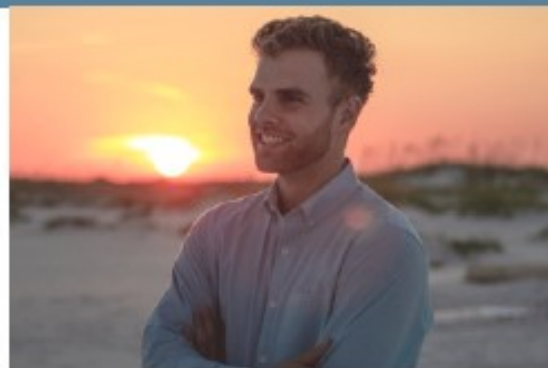

The CPD Exam



The 2025 CPD exam has passed but now is a great time to start hitting the books for the 2026 exam. The exam is offered once a year, usually in April. To be eligible to take the CPD Examination, a candidate must possess:

- Full ASPE membership or previously received approval to sit for the exam; or

- A minimum of four years of experience in a position of responsibility for the design of plumbing systems and possess a baccalaureate degree in a field related to engineering; or

- In lieu of an accredited degree, a candidate may substitute up to an additional four years of practical experience in the design of plumbing systems, for a total of eight years, or be granted a credit of one-half year of practical experience for each full year of education in an accredited curriculum related to plumbing engineering.

CPDT Certification counts towards 1 year of experience.

We are starting up a study group. If this interests you, please contact me or one of the ASPE South Florida Board Members for further information.

In addition, the ASPE South Florida elections are coming up. If you are interested in becoming more active, please contact me or another board member. There is much to do, and positions are open to becoming a part of this great society.

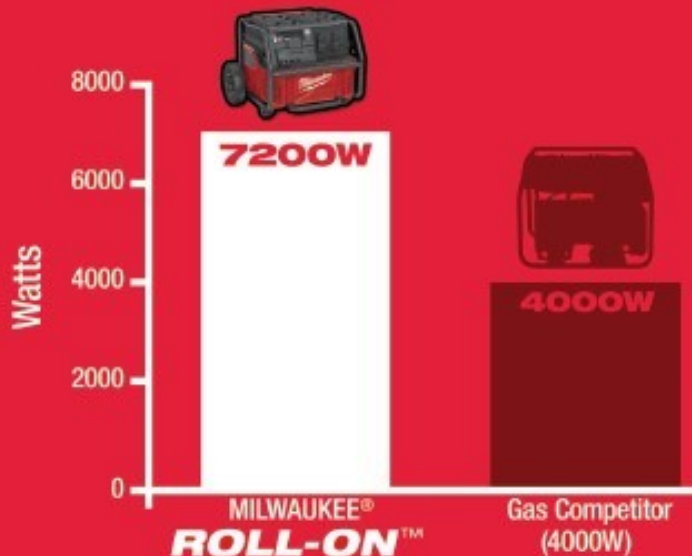

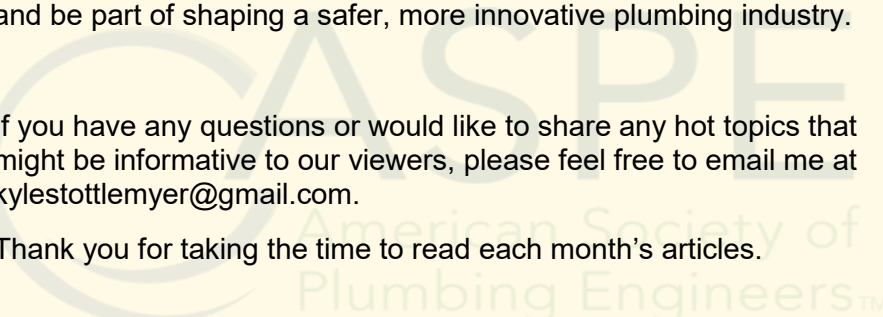

Greetings Members,

Legislative news—Natural Gas Ban Backlash---Did you know the Department of Energy (DOE) has mandated a nationwide gas water heaters to be banned? The gas water heaters account for 40%, so the water heater manufacturers will have to re-engineer their production line. DOE estimates that the consumer will save approximately \$100 a year, but the response has been the upfront cost will far exceed that savings. A total of 26 states have already passed laws prohibiting natural gas water heater bans. The nation's first ban on natural gas hookups in new buildings---in Berkeley, Calif.—was also repealed earlier this year, after a federal appeals court ruled it violated federal law. ref. 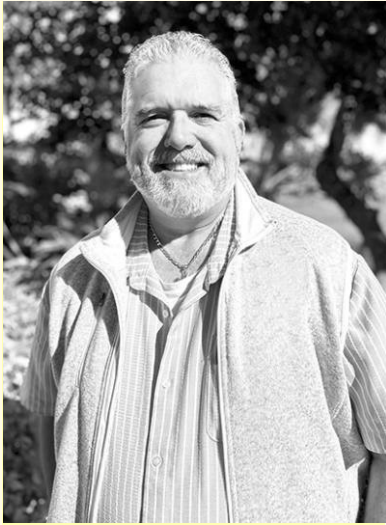

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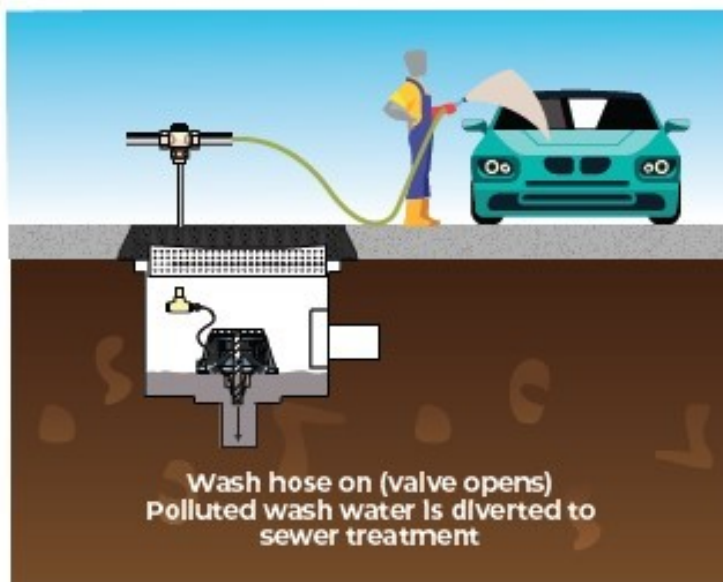
