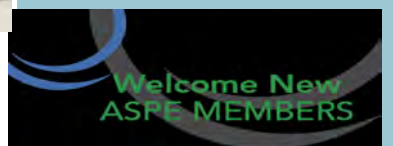

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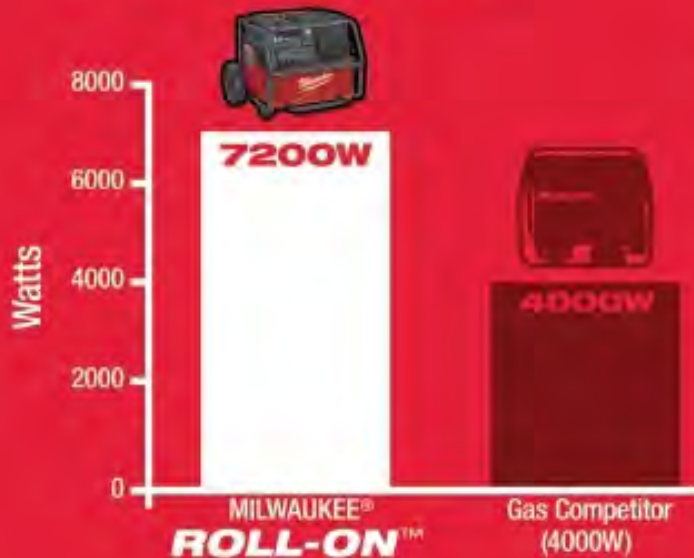

ASPE is a member of and approved by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) as an ANSI-accredited standards developer. As such, ASPE may submit standards for approval by ANSI's Board of Standards Review as meeting certain criteria regarding due process in development to be designated as American National Standards.

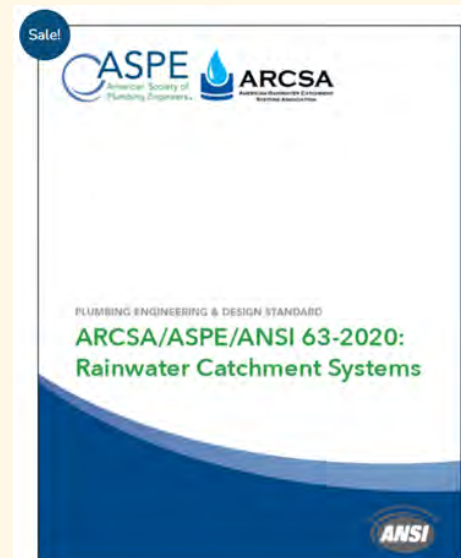

This American National Standard was developed through a partnership between ASPE and the American Rainwater Catchment Systems Association (ARCSA). The standard is designed to assist engineers, designers, plumbers, builders/developers, local government officials, and end users in safely implementing a rainwater catchment system using precipitation from rooftops and other hard, impervious surfaces for use for irrigation, laundry, hygiene, or even potable water applications if the appropriate treatment and materials have been certified for the specific end use. The 2020 update supersedes the 2013 version of this standard.

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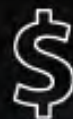

Plumbing engineers in Florida must adhere to the Florida Building Code – Plumbing (2023 Edition), which incorporates the International Plumbing Code with state-specific amendments. Additionally, Florida Administrative Code 61G15-34.007 outlines the scope of plumbing engineering, emphasizing the need for licensed professionals to design systems that handle water, gases, and waste safely and efficiently.

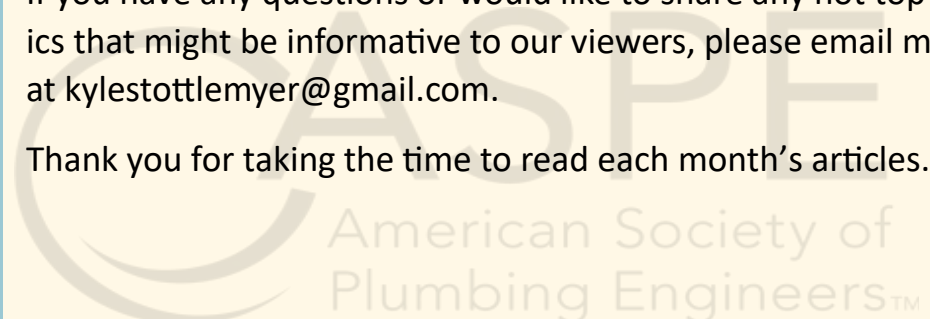

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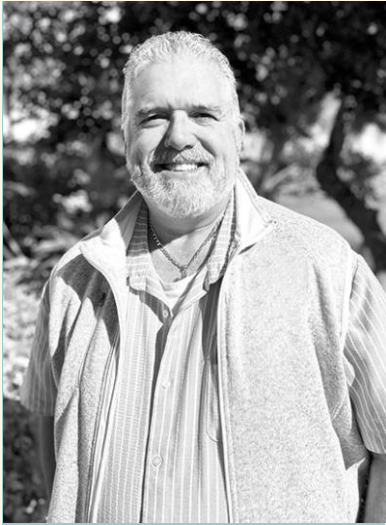
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VP-Legislative Interim Report—Emilio Sorondo



Florida Building Code Updates – 2025

Key changes to the **Florida Plumbing Code** and **Building Code** include:

- **Water Heater Placement:** New rules for location and seismic strapping, applicable even in South Florida.
- **Shut-Off Valve Access:** Must be clearly labeled and accessible.
- **Backflow Devices:** Annual testing and documentation now required statewide.
- **Pipe Materials:** Galvanized pipes are discouraged and may affect insurance renewals.
- **Scald Prevention:** Thermostatic and pressure-balancing valves are now mandatory; max fixture temp capped at 120°F.
- **Flood Preparedness:** Fixtures in flood-prone areas must meet elevation requirements above Base Flood Elevation (BFE).

House Bill 1461 – Building Code Overhaul

This proposed bill aims to:

- Strengthen safety standards for **structural, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and energy systems**.
- Mandate uniform standards for **residential swimming pool barriers** and **safety devices**.
- Address safety in **healthcare centers, assisted living, and hospice care** facilities.
- Raise concerns about increased compliance costs for builders and developers.

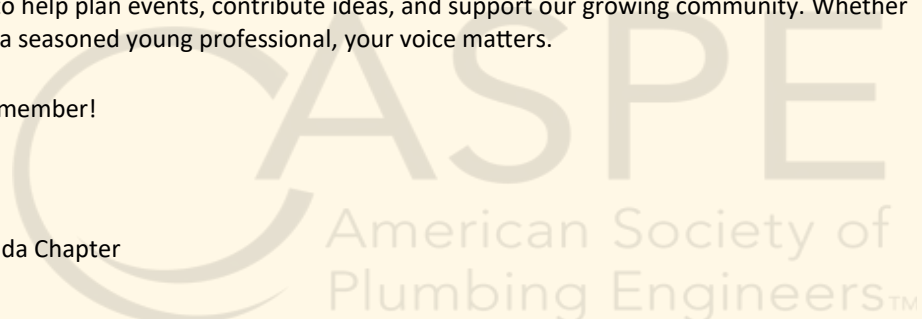

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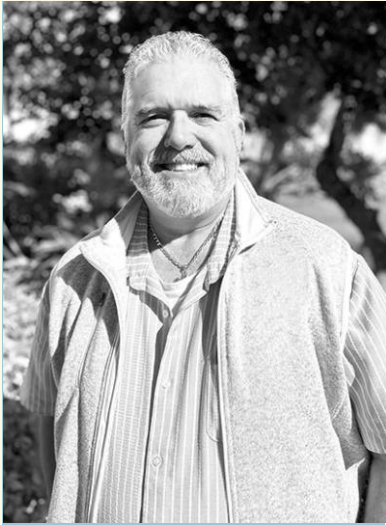
