Standards Development

The American Society of Plumbing Engineers is committed to helping plumbing engineers design high-quality plumbing systems that protect public health and safety by developing consensus standards on plumbing system design practices. ASPE is a member of and approved by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) as an ANSI-accredited standards developer. As such, ASPE may submit standards for approval by ANSI's Board of Standards Review as meeting certain criteria regarding due process in development to be designated as American National Standards.

ASPE/ANSI 45-2025 establishes the minimum performance specifications for siphonic roof drainage systems and is intended to provide designers, installers, and code officials with a standard of practice for the proper application of siphonic roof drainage. ASPE/ANSI 45 applies to engineered siphonic roof drainage systems intended to prime and operate full-bore through proper pipe dimensioning and the use of siphonic roof drains. It does not apply to conventional roof drains covered under ANSI/ASME A112.6.4, atmospheric roof drainage systems, or sanitary drainage systems.



ASPE/ANSI 45-2025 supersedes ASPE/ANSI 45-2018. It was approved as an American National Standard by the American National Standards Institute on May 5, 2025.

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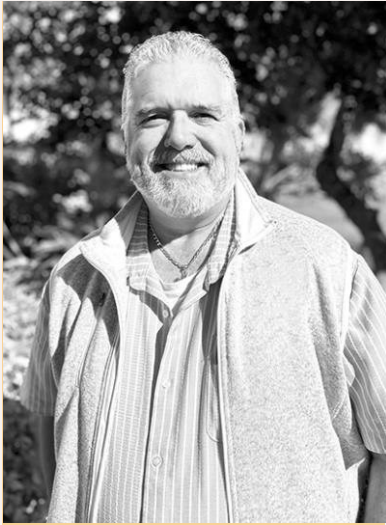

🔍 What's Ahead for Plumbing Engineers in South Florida – 2026 & Beyond

🔍 Atmospheric Water Heaters Facing Phase-Out

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has finalized new efficiency standards that will **effectively ban most non-condensing gas water heaters** starting in **2026**:

- **Condensing Technology Required:** Traditional atmospheric models won't meet the new efficiency thresholds.
- **Impact:** Manufacturers must redesign units; installers will need to adapt to heavier, more complex systems.

Timeline: Compliance required by **December 26, 2029**, but many models will begin disappearing from shelves by **2026**.

🔍 ASME Code Overhaul for Plumbing Vessels

The **2025 ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code (BPVC)** introduces major changes affecting water heaters and other plumbing pressure vessels:

- **New Subsection:** Many appendices have been reorganized for clarity and usability.
- **Harmonization:** Section VIII, Division 1 is being aligned with Division 2, Part 4 — expect more design-by-analysis requirements.

Effective Date: Mandatory for all pressure vessels contracted after **January 1, 2026**.

🔍 ECM Motors Likely to Become Mandatory

Electronically Commutated Motors (ECMs) are gaining traction due to their ultra-premium efficiency (IE5):

- **DOE Push:** ECMs are expected to be required in circulator pumps and small HVAC motors under upcoming federal rules.
- **Benefits:** Lower energy use, quieter operation, and reduced maintenance.

Florida Adoption: While not yet mandated statewide, ECMs are being promoted in new builds and retrofits, especially in high-efficiency plumbing and HVAC systems.

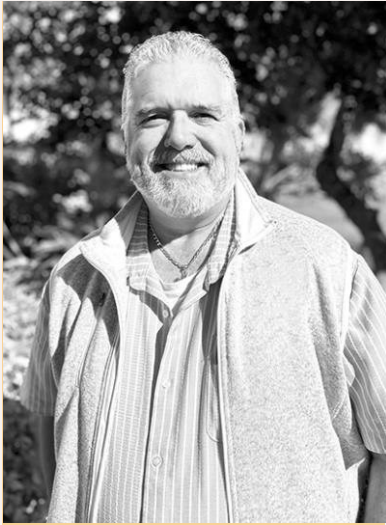

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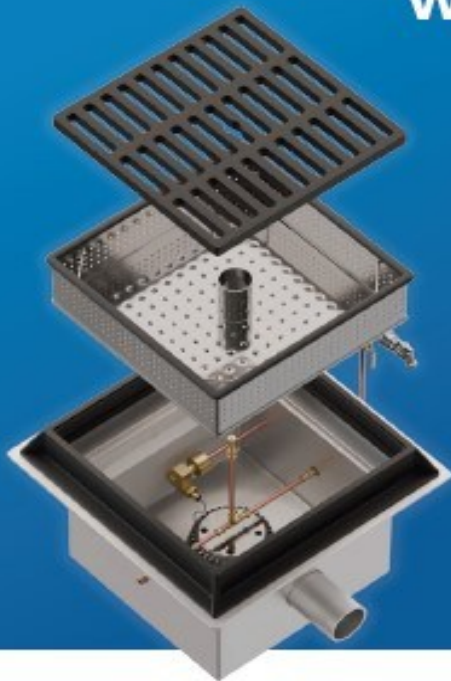
