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Legislative News



Enrique (Henry) Salvador—VP-Legislative

Hello to all, and I hope you had a safe and meaningful Thanksgiving. This month I would like to talk about a formal interpretation that was approved by the Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals at the November 17th 2022 Meeting. The Board approved an interpretation of Section P607.2 of the Florida Building Code (FBC) Plumbing, 7th Edition and Section C404.5 Of the FBC Energy Conservation, 7th Edition, which will only apply to commercial buildings.

The intent of the Florida Energy Conservation, Section C404.5 is to limit the amount of hot water and energy wasted between the source of hot water to come out of the fixture. the FBC Plumbing Section 607.2 limits the length of the hot water to 50' before a circulating line is required. Section C404.5 of the energy code is more specific and restrictive to the of piping or the amount of water wasted.

C404.5 Efficient heated water supply piping.

- Heated water supply piping shall be in accordance with Section C404.5.1 or C404.5.2.
- The flow rate through $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch (6.4 mm) piping shall be not greater than 0.5 gpm. (1.9 L/m).
- The flow rate through $\frac{5}{16}$ -inch (7.9 mm) piping shall be not greater than 1 gpm. (3.8 L/m).
- The flow rate through $\frac{3}{8}$ -inch (9.5 mm) piping shall be not greater than 1.5 gpm. (5.7 L/m).

Legislative News (cont.)

C404.5.1 Maximum allowable pipe length method.

The maximum allowable piping length from the nearest source of heated water to the termination of the fixture supply pipe shall be in accordance with the following. Where the piping contains more than one size of pipe, the largest size of pipe within the piping shall be used for determining the maximum allowable length of the piping in Table C404.5.1.

1. For a public lavatory faucet, use the "Public lavatory faucets" column in Table C404.5.1.
2. For all other plumbing fixtures and plumbing appliances, use the "Other fixtures and appliances" column in Table C404.5.1.

As you can see you the distance to require a circulating line can be reduced to 21'. Therefor requiring a return line, insulation and a method of turning off the circulating pump when the hot water reaches the set temperature.

I am sure Dade County will be following in the near future.
