



February: Heart Month for Our Profession

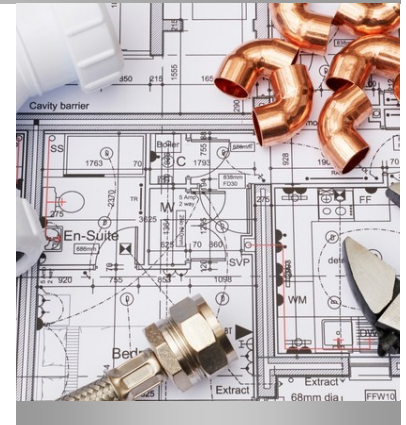

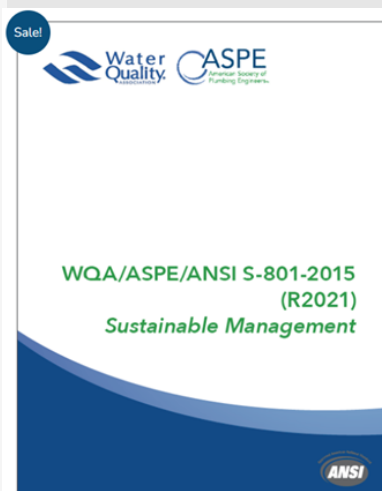

WQA/ASPE/ANSI S-802 is a complementary standard to WQA/ASPE/ANSI S-803: Sustainable Drinking Water Treatment Systems. The 2017 version was reaffirmed in 2022

This business-to-business standard focuses on the sustainability of the two most common treatment media used in water filter systems: activated carbon and ion-exchange resin. It evaluates the sustainability of these media products based on core attributes common to both products types (health and safety, emissions and consumptions, and end of life), as well as product type requirements (modules) based on the specific environmental impacts of either the activated carbon or ion-exchange resin.

WQA/ASPE/ANSI S-802 is a complementary standard to WQA/ASPE/ANSI S-803: Sustainable Drinking Water Treatment Systems. Manufacturers interested in certifying to S-803 drinking water treatment unit (DWTU) systems that utilize either (or both) of these media types are awarded maximum credit if said media is certified to S-802. Certification to this standard helps a company establish market preferability with their customers interested in purchasing more environmentally friendly treatment media for use in their DWTU systems.

As AYP continues to gain momentum within our chapter, we will be organizing additional networking events to help young engineers connect in fun, relaxed environments.

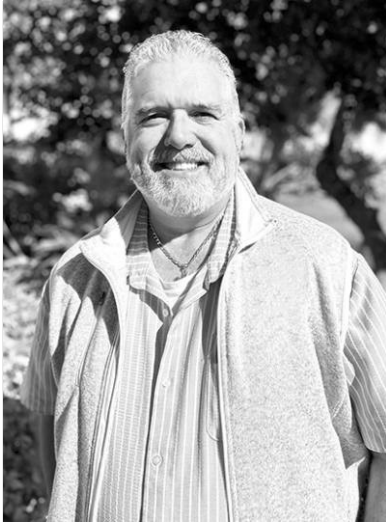

VP-Legislative Interim Report—Emilio Sorondo



Legislative & Code Update for South Florida Plumbing Engineers

As we begin 2026, several developments from the Florida Building Commission and the state legislature are poised to influence engineering practice across South Florida. The Florida Building Commission continues its work on the **9th Edition (2026) Florida Building Code**, with new amendments under review following the December 2025 commission meetings. Proposed code changes—spanning plumbing, mechanical, energy, and structural systems—are currently in the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) review cycle, where comments submitted by January 30, 2026, are being evaluated. Engineers should pay particular attention to revisions within the **Plumbing and Mechanical TAC Tracking Charts**, which reflect modifications pulled for individual consideration, including updates tied to referenced standards and compliance pathways. These updates will shape design requirements for the next code cycle, and engineers are encouraged to monitor the ongoing rule development workshops scheduled through March 2026. In January 2026, Florida lawmakers also advanced significant legislation impacting building departments, private providers, and design professionals. **House Bill 803**, currently in committee, proposes major changes to building permit requirements and the inspection process. Notably, the bill introduces new rules governing permit expiration timelines, limits discipline for certain unpermitted work, and expands the conditions under which private providers can act with authority similar to local building officials. It also requires the Florida Building Commission to develop **uniform commercial and residential permit applications**, streamlining submissions statewide. For engineers, this could alter how submittals are prepared, reviewed, and coordinated with AHJs, with implementation targeted for July 1, 2026. [\[flsenate.gov\]](http://flsenate.gov)

Additionally, **House Bill 911**, filed at the end of 2025 and read in the House on January 13, 2026, proposes new construction requirements for impact-resistant materials. This bill directs the Florida Building Commission to incorporate enhanced wind-borne debris and impact-resistance provisions into the *next* edition of the Florida Building Code. Given South Florida's hurricane exposure, engineers should stay alert to how these changes may affect material selection, equipment protection, rooftop installations, and exterior system design. Both HB 803 and HB 911 reflect a wider statewide focus on resilience, uniformity, and efficiency in permitting and construction—trends likely to grow as we approach the 2026 hurricane season



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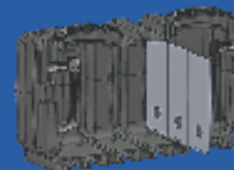

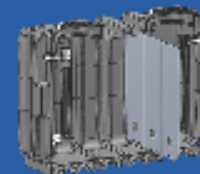
