Standards Development - Sustainable Drinking Water Treatment Systems

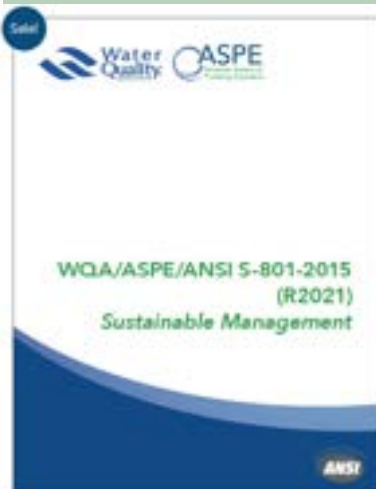

ASPE is a member of and approved by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) as an ANSI-accredited standards developer. As such, ASPE may submit standards for approval by ANSI's Board of Standards Review as meeting certain criteria regarding due process in development to be designated as American National Standards.

WQA/ASPE/ANSI S-803 (2017): Sustainable Drinking Water Treatment Systems is an American National Standard that will help manufacturers establish market leadership by certifying product sustainability via a program of monitoring and improvement throughout all phases of the product life-cycle. It evaluates the sustainability of these systems based on core attributes common to all products types (health and safety, product design, emissions and consumptions, supplier engagement, and end-of-life), as well as product type specific requirements (modules) based on the specific environmental impacts of each product category type included in the scope of the standard. The scope of S-803 includes drinking water filter products that utilize activated carbon, UV systems, dispensers/fountains, cation exchange softeners and other treatment systems that utilize ion exchange resins. S-803 is a complementary standard to WQA/ASPE/ANSI S-802 (2017): Sustainable Water Treatment Media. Activated carbon systems and systems that utilize ion exchange resins get maximum credit towards conformance with this standard if that treatment media is certified to WQA/ASPE/ANSI S-802.

Legislative & Regulatory Update

DOE Energy Policy – March 2026 Snapshot

As we move into **Spring 2026**, plumbing engineers should remain aware of ongoing federal energy policy activity from the **U.S. Department of Energy (DOE)** that continues to influence equipment selection and system design for commercial projects.

While **no new DOE plumbing-related energy conservation standards become effective specifically in March 2026**, the Department remains active in rulemaking and enforcement that will shape future requirements for plumbing systems.

Current areas of focus include **commercial water heaters and boilers**, where existing federal efficiency standards remain in place and future updates are under consideration, particularly related to thermal efficiency, standby losses, and control integration for larger-capacity equipment.

The DOE also continues enforcement of efficiency provisions affecting **commercial pumps and pump motors**, reinforcing the importance of proper sizing, variable speed operation, and coordinated system design to meet energy performance expectations.

Although DOE regulations apply at the manufacturing level, their impact is reflected through **ASHRAE 90.1**, the **International Energy Conservation Code (IECC)**, and future plumbing and mechanical code cycles.

In South Florida, many public and institutional projects already reference **current or anticipated DOE efficiency levels**, even before formal state adoption, making early awareness critical for engineers.

March 2026 represents continued momentum—not a sudden shift—toward **higher-efficiency plumbing systems and increased energy accountability**.
