Enrique (Henry) Salvador—VP-Legislative



Hello...and what a crazy month this has been. I would like to first send my condolences to the 119 lives that were lost last month due to Hurricane Ian. I would also like to wish a speedy recovery to our neighbors on the West Coast.

This hurricane has started a lot of discussion in our industry. This storm was a powerful and devastating and it has been the highlight of many meetings all over the state. Many state and local agencies have been meeting and looking at areas that have been built to the Florida test protocols for the High Velocity Hurricane Zones.. Even though this code is only a requirement for Dade and Broward counties, some developments and personal properties have been built using these codes in other parts of Florida.

In Mexico Beach, we saw the destruction all around one house that was built to these standards with minimal damage. We have also seen reports and pictures of Babcock Ranch where services were only interrupted for one day. With the rising costs of insurance and building materials, we believe that this will be a warranted conversation in the upcoming year to look at changes for the 2026 codes.

The issue of mobile homes is another discussion that is important. Every time that we watch the news, the first thing that they show is the damage to trailer parks. With over 800,000 mobile homes, Florida has the most in the country. Legislation for this issue is also being looked at for the upcoming codes.

Why Do Pipes Burst in Winter?

Contrary to popular belief, it's not because of ice expanding inside the pipes. Without going into too much scientific detail, when water freezes inside pipes, the water molecules expand. The ice then expands and pushes the water toward the faucet, causing a significant amount of pressure buildup between the ice blockage inside the pipe and the faucet. Eventually, the pipe can't take the pressure buildup and it bursts. The rupture usually occurs in a location in the pipe where there's little to no ice.
