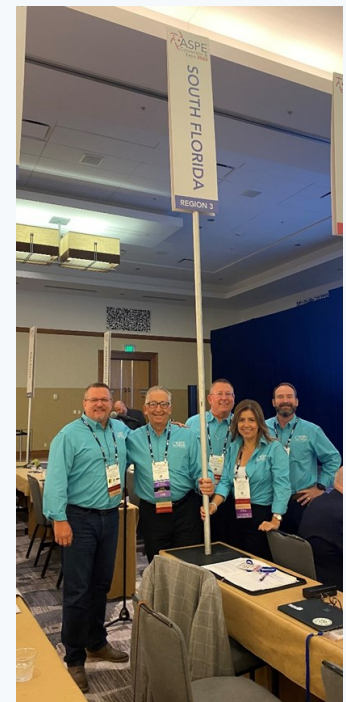

I would like to welcome everyone back who attended this year's ASPE 2022 Convention. I heard and saw pictures that it was a great success. This month I would like to present a new form that will be required for obtaining a permit for the replacements of Electric Water Heaters in Broward County.

The Board of Rules and Appeals has approved a mandatory supplemental countywide individual permit form when a residential water heater is replaced. This new form is used in addition to the Uniform Building Permit application form when a water heater in a residence is replaced. This form is used for convience throughout Broward County so that one form can be used consistently. Water heaters with a plug-in cord must be replaced and an electrical permit is required. The new wiring shall have a means of disconnect and be hard-wired. This form is Broward County Board of Rules Appeals website, [Code Appeals Uniform Countywide Forms \(broward.org\)](http://broward.org). The form is fillable, easy to use, and designed to avoid issues in the field with the scope of work. This affects Plumbing and Electrical Contractors.
