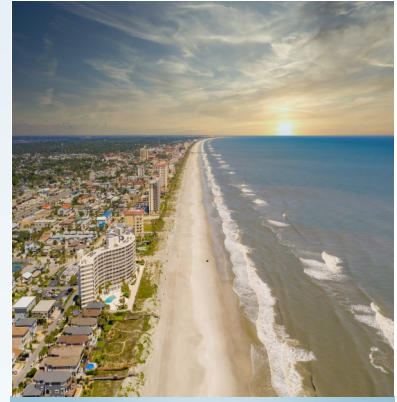

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Legislative News

Enrique (Henry) Salvador—VP-Legislative

Welcome back from the heat of the Summer of 2022....I hope that everyone had a safe and fun summer.

I would like to continue with my previous report on how Tallahassee has been busy this year. On May 28th, Governor DeSantis signed House Bill 959 that went into effect on July 1st. This is a lengthy Bill that was passed by the Commerce Committee, the Finance and Facilities Subcommittee, and the Insurance and Banking Committee.

In general, the Bill requires Department of Financial Services to create a secure online portal to accept service of process; authorizes specified persons to purchase coverage in state group health insurance plan at specified premium costs. It also provides changes to Workers Compensation, and the requirement for a Carbon Monoxide (CO) detector connected to boilers in public assembly locations.

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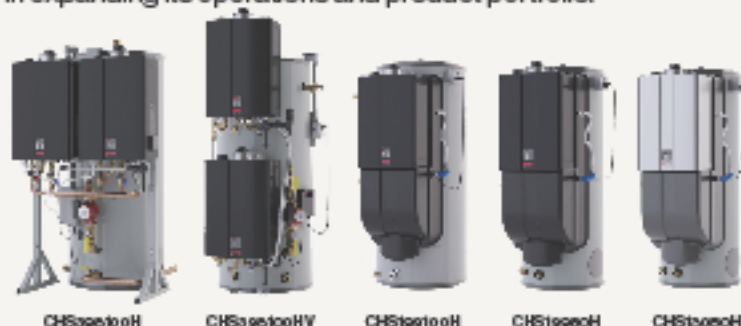
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Affiliate Report
